



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

MUHAMMADIYAH AND THE GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRALIA

Muhammadiyah and the Government of Australia hereafter referred to as the 'Parties';

- Recognising the good relations between the peoples of Indonesia and Australia;
- Recognising the significant role of Muhammadiyah in the development of a democratic and tolerant society in Indonesia and their role in delivering basic services and helping communities prepare and respond to disasters;
- Recalling the Lombok Treaty's recognition of the importance of building Community Understanding and People-to-People Cooperation;
- Recognising the Australian Indonesian Partnership Strategy 2008-2013 to achieve a prosperous, democratic and care Indonesia;
- Recognising the extensive partnership between the Parties in education, governance, disaster relief and activities to promote better understanding between the peoples of Australia and Indonesia;
- Acknowledging the significant reach and capacity of Muhammadiyah to improve the well being of the community;
- Seeking to deepen the cooperation between the Parties in a variety of sectors with the Government of Australia;
- Pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulations in their respective countries, have reached the following understanding:
